Whilst no specific experience is required, it is important that you have a passion for the environment and for the ecological restoration of native bush.

Applicants must have:

- Good level of fitness
- Desire to work outdoors, to work hard, and to be accepting of all weather conditions and terrain
- Full driving licence (NZ class 1)
- NZ Citizen or NZ Permanent Resident status or valid NZ work permit
- A passion for the natural environment and its protection
- Positive can-do attitude and the ability to work well in a team
- Ability to work away from home during the working week

Beneficial:

- Experience in similar roles
- Knowledge of invasive plants and their effective control
- Knowledge of plants native to NZ
- Current First Aid, Growsafe and other relevant qualifications in environmental management

The starting wage for field worker roles is \$15.50 per hour, however we would also welcome applications from those with experience in this area of work and with a leadership background. We have other field roles available at Te Ngahere which carry more responsibility and a related wage.
